

While this is true, it is believed that the subject under consideration, hydrographic surveying, does not require profound discussion, and that plain, direct treatment of the subject matter will be productive of the best results. No attempt has been made to introduce complicated mathematical formulas into the text since it is believed that ultra refinement in a hydraulic formula for discharge would be out of place in view of the impossibility of making ordinary field measurements with microscopic exactness.
